Program Options (50-minute Program Sessions)

Scholarship:

Key Issues in Student Affairs:

- How has your campus, division, or department addressed a key issue in the field (e.g., alcohol, retention, diversity, service learning, sexual assault, Greek life)

Best Practices in the Field:

- Assist other professionals to become more effective and efficient (e.g., time management, successful meetings, chairing committees, developing collaborative relationships, dealing with change and transition, assessment techniques, balancing personal time with professional responsibilities, career development, etc.)

Submission Information:

All proposals will be submitted electronically. Submission instructions are available on the “Annual Conference” section of the SACSA website. You will be asked to include the following:

- Program abstract
- Learning outcomes
- Relationship to conference theme
- Program format
- Methods for involvement
- Background of presenters, and
- Evidence of program content.
